



Transitional Housing Application Packet

Second Step Housing's Transitional Housing Program provides safe affordable housing for homeless women and their children while they receive comprehensive case management to build skills and move toward self-sufficiency. Participants live in group homes for up to 24 months, where they are expected to be clean and sober, participate in case management and house meetings, and take part in group education courses to build life skills. Monthly rents are affordable and based on a percentage of participants' income.

The program is open to single, homeless women with or without children who are willing to develop and commit to a self-sufficiency plan with her case manager. Prospective tenants must complete this entire application packet, including the verification of income and verification of homelessness.

As housing becomes available, we will screen qualified applicants to determine whether you are an appropriate fit for the program. We will contact you when housing becomes available, so please keep us informed if your contact information changes so we can reach you. You do not need to contact the office to check the status of your application.
